Welcome to the second annual GP Lens Institute (GPLI) Annual Report. 2022 was truly a very productive and rewarding year as is described in this report and 2023 should be even more exciting due to the large expansion in our programs, resources, committees, and the outstanding experts who help us on a daily basis. Our Development and Marketing Coordinator, Beth Anderzhon, has demonstrated her creativity and innovativeness in everything we are able to accomplish as her fingerprints are all over our programs, resources, and a greatly updated website. We are very excited to announce that well respected clinician, author, lecturer, and leader, Dr. Tom Quinn joined our family as Associate Director on January 1, 2023. Beth and Dr. Quinn compliment the efforts of our dedicated GPLI Board of Directors, our renown group of experts – the GPLI Advisory Board, the Cornea and Contact Lens Resident Advisory Board, our 10 committees consisting of Advisory Board members and "Rising Stars", and the ongoing assistance provided by CLMA Administrative Director, Pam Witham and Ursula Lotzkat and Wink Productions.



We continued to revise our resources in 2022. Our monthly newsletter has a new and improved look and format. Our Cornea and Contact Lens Residents Symposium at the Indiana University School of Optometry, under the direction of Advisory Board member Dr. Jason Jedlicka, was a huge success. We continued to provide workshop programs at colleges of optometry and we continued to have outstanding attendance at our monthly educational webinars to ECPs and quarterly webinars to students. COPE approval was available for the last seven webinars of the year. Our development program continues to grow and we are so appreciative of the support of our CLMA Industry Partners, as well as donations provided by many of our Advisory Board members and other supporters who are prominently listed in this report. In particular, Drs. Stephanie Woo and Shannon Steinhauser were very supportive of an annual award in the name of Dr. Art Epstein. Our clinical externships program, with the goal of increasing the number of sites for 4th year optometry students to receive specialty contact lens experience under the direction of committee chair Dr. Gloria Chiu, continues to grow along with our first of four "How To" modules — "I Have a GP Wearer in My Chair: What Do I Do" under the direction of committee co-chairs Drs. Jennifer Harthan and Michelle Man.

2023 is off to an outstanding start with the introduction of our most ambitious program, our GPLI Eye Care Professionals membership program which includes 14 benefits to members for a low annual fee. This includes "The Advisor", a bimonthly online clinical journal edited by Drs. Jennifer Harthan and Melanie Frogozo, and quarterly podcasts ("GPLI Radio") as moderated by Dr. Tom Quinn. Again, the GPLI was a Gold Sponsor of the Global Specialty Lens Symposium held January 18–21, in Las Vegas. The GPLI sponsored a track of education, the registration of contact lens educators, a booth, and the social highlight of GSLS, the Rising Stars reception. This year the GPLI honored six very deserving individuals at this reception with the Naomi "Jo" Svochak GPLI Practitioner of the Year award to Dr. Gloria Chiu; the Dr. Edward S. Bennett Educator of the Year Award to Dr. Langis Michaud; the Thomas J. "Tommy" Pham Keratoconus Practitioner of the Year award – presented by Tommy personally – to Dr. Clark Chang, the Thomas E. Anastor Distinguished Service Award to Pam Witham and Ursula Lotzkat, and the newly established Dr. Arthur B. Epstein GPLI Award of Excellence in Specialty Contact Lenses and Anterior Segment Disease presented to Dr. Epstein with the award accepted by Dr. Steinhauser. The "I Have a GP Wearer in My Chair: What Do I Do" module should be introduced in 2023 while initial development of the second module, "I Have a Young Myope in My Chair: What's Next?" will be occurring.

Our goal continues, as always, to be THE source for GP and custom soft lens education. Thank you for your support in helping us reach this goal.







#### THINGS TO CELEBRATE

We revised the **Contact Lens Clinical Pearls Pocket Guide**, with contributions from 19

experts in the field.

We fulfilled **427 orders** and shipped **56,945 educational resources** to eye care professionals nationwide.

The decision was made to hire additional

staff to assist with program development, and longtime GPLI advocate Dr. Tom Quinn was offered the **Associate Director** position beginning January 1, 2023.

We earned the **Candid Silver Seal of Transparency** on GuideStar.

2 new awards were presented for the first time at our Rising Stars Reception: the Thomas J. "Tommy" Pham GPLI – NKCF Keratoconus Practitioner of the Year award and the Thomas E. Anastor GPLI Distinguished Service Award. Major league baseball player Tommy Pham, who has keratoconus, served as keynote speaker, presented his award, and stayed for photos.

We **redesigned the GPLI website** with an updated look and functionality.

We **educated 3,000 people** via webinars, workshops, and presentations.

The **GPLI ECP Membership Program** was established and set to begin in 2023, with 14 premier resources available to members.

25 GP Clinical Excellence Awards were given to 4th year optometry students at the colleges of optometry for outstanding achievement with GP contact lenses.

The 24th annual **GPLI Cornea and Contact Lens Residents Symposium** was hosted by the Indiana University School of Optometry and involved 38 residents and fellows. The program included 8 virtual lectures & CLMA resource videos, a 3 hour live online grand rounds program, and 3 days of in–person workshops, lectures, and panels at IU.

We laid the groundwork for a program to establish new **specialty contact lens externship sites**, providing resources for efficient and successful integration.

Beth Anderzhon became a COPE administrator, and we began offering **COPE** accredited webinars.
